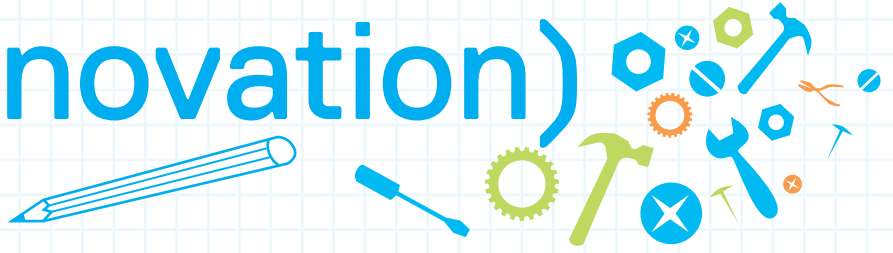

Shoe-IN(novation) Design Dash



DESIGN A SHOE THAT INCORPORATES THE ART OF ENGINEERING

Shoe-IN(novation) Design Dash celebrates multidisciplinary innovation with footwear designs that combine art, science and technology. Through the design process, teams will articulate an inspiration they have for how shoes can solve a problem or meet a need.

Teams will submit a design notebook and a completed shoe prototype. Teams will have five minutes to present their shoe and design notebook to the judges. Winning designs will go on display at the *The Art of Fashion "all about shoes"* exhibition at Adrienne Arsht Center curated by Luis Valenzuela at the Adrienne Arsht Center for the Performing Arts at the start of ArtWeek Miami and Art Basel 2014. All designs will be presented at the Patricia and Phillip Frost Museum of Science Innovation and Engineering Weekend, February 2015.

How to Apply

The competition is open to all public and private middle schools in Miami-Dade County. Teams may consist of 3 to 10 middle school students each. Individual teams must be mentored by one or two teachers. Due to the multidisciplinary nature of design, we recommend that an art/design teacher team up with a science/technology teacher. 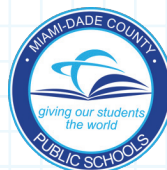
